- Scott Rieckmann**- RW Management should have a draft of all the equipment evaluation available soon. A draft is expected September 23.
- David Pavlik**- still waiting on an equipment list, and waiting on copies of insurance policies-insurance summaries and how the premium was calculated.
- There was a comment made that a new fire department wouldn't be able to use the current state ID number. Scott Rieckmann said that it would be up to the state board to decide that. A new fire department ID number can be issued within 24 hour of submitting the request form and providing the required information.
- Ben Joas**- It was decided at the Joint Fire Board meeting that the Town of Clayton is going to prepare a document for the Town of Winchester to contract with Clayton for the 1st Responders. It would be for what Winchester is currently paying.
- The Wisconsin Fire Service Book was discussed.
- A letter was handed out to the committee from a group wishing to form a Volunteer Winchester Fire Department and First Responder Squad. It will be on the agenda for the Town Board meeting Monday night. Discussion was held. Dave Pavlik commented that such action is premature pending further study.
- Denise Kempen** expressed her wish to circulate a petition to contract with the Town of Clayton for fire and first responder services. Dave Pavlik commented that such a petition may be premature pending further study.
- David Pavlik**- Is going to submit a resolution to the Town Board to delay any action leading to the dissolution of the Joint Fire Board and Fire Department for one year and to continue with the study of what to do for the Town of Winchester.
- Scott Rieckmann**- as of January 1, 2016 the Town of Clayton will not be putting money in the joint fire department account anymore. Clayton has prepared their budget for next year.
- David Pavlik**-The Joint Fire Board has not been dissolved so the agreement still stands and must be supported.
